What is it?

Expenses associated with an accident are unexpected, but an accident's impact on your finances and your well-being can be reduced. Aflac Group Accident insurance assists you with leftover medical bills, replacement of income, and routine living expenses. The plan provides 24-hour coverage, which means you're covered at home and at work. Benefits include:

- Emergency room treatment
- Major diagnostic testing
- Fractures, dislocations, lacerations and burns
- Hospital admission, confinement and intensive care
- Accident follow-up treatment
- Physical therapy
- Accidental death and dismemberment, and many more

The plan also provides a \$1,000 Gunshot Wound benefit.

Why would I enroll?

Aflac's Group Accident plan complements major medical coverage, and helps provide a financial safety net so you can protect your income and your family's financial security. Coverage includes the following features:

- Cash benefits paid directly to you – unless assigned otherwise
- Available for all family members; dependents are eligible if the employee is eligible and participates; spouse-only and child-only coverage is unavailable
- Guaranteed-issue for eligible applicants
- No pre-existing conditions limitation
- No waiting period
- Coverage may be continued if you leave the company or retire (with certain stipulations)

How It Works:

You injure your leg in a covered accident and go to the hospital via ambulance.

The emergency room doctor X-rays, diagnoses a fracture and treats you.

You leave the hospital on crutches.
